

Foreign Student Scholarship Application Guideline (Fall Semester, 2025)

1. Eligibility

- Foreign graduate school students who will enroll for their regular semester in fall semester 2025.
 - * Students who will register for their "additional semester for credit earning" or "research semester" or "enrolled degree candidates(수료연구학생)" or "students planning to have a leave of absence" as of fall semester 2025, **are not eligible for application.**
 - * GKS scholars and joint/dual degree students **are not eligible for application.**
- All requirements for application should be met. (please refer to the '2. Requirements')
- Students who wish for the scholarship should apply for every semester.

- **Requirement I: GPA of spring semester 2025(Confirmed GPA to be announced on 9th July 2025 afternoon)**
 - * If the GPA is not confirmed at the time of application, students can apply for several scholarships(However, the students can receive only one of scholarships applied.)
 - * If the applicant's GPA does not meet the requirement, the application will be canceled automatically.
- **Requirement II: Completion of Compulsory Education for Foreign Students**
(①Human Rights and Gender Equality Education and ②Crime Prevention Education)
 - * From Fall 2023, only those students who have already taken the compulsory courses can apply for the scholarships.
 - * Please find the other attached files to check "Course sign-up guideline" and "Certificate issuance guideline".
 - * Compulsory education completion date required for the scholarship application

① Human Rights and Gender Equality Education (인권과 성평등 교육)	the education needs to be attended within “the academic year” of scholarship application date is included (Example) When applying for the scholarship for fall semester 2025 in Jun. 2025: The education must be attended within 2025 academic year period(Mar. 2025 ~)
② Crime Prevention Education (범죄예방교육)	The education needs to be attended within “the semester” of scholarship application date is included (Example) When applying for the scholarship for fall semester 2025 in Jun. 2025: The education must be attended during the spring semester 2025(Mar. 2025 ~)

3. Scholarship Application Procedure and Result Announcement

- **Application Period:** 10th(Tue.) June 2025 – 6th(Sun.) July 2025, by 23:59KST
- How to Apply:
Visit KUPID(<http://portal.korea.ac.kr>) → Log-in → Registration/Scholarship(등록/장학) → Scholarship(장학) → Register the Scholarship(대학원 장학금 신청)
- Required Documents(ALL the documents must be **MERGED into one PDF** file and be submitted.)
(Please upload at KUPID)
 - ① Application form and Statement of ability for an applicant
 - ② Certificate of completion for each compulsory education for foreign students
 - * Please find the other attached files to check “Course sign-up guideline” and “Certificate issuance guideline”.
- **Result Announcement in mid Aug. 2025(expected),**
How to check: KUPID – Scholarship - Scholarship/Student Loan Recipients(장학금 수혜내역)
 - * The scholarship recipient selection will be conducted from applicant’s affiliated college through evaluation of applicant’s overall academic ability.
